The Community Schools is a national model where schools serve as the hub of the community providing both academic and social-emotional support for students and their families. As defined by the Coalition of Community Schools, "A Community School is a public school - the hub of its neighborhood, uniting families, educators and community partners to provide all students with top-quality academics, enrichment, health and social services, and opportunities to succeed in school and in life."

The goal of Community Schools is to help ensure students and their families are resilient, successful, ready to learn and are prepared to be involved in their community. Homeroom Teacher Assignment Cards

You will receive your child's teacher assignment via postal mail the week of August 8, 2022. The card will contain your child's assigned teacher, classroom number, and current grade. Parents, please share this information with your child to ensure that on the first day of school, he/she can report to the correct homeroom teacher.

Mandatory Uniform Policy Dress Code

Paint Branch Elementary School is a <u>MANDATORY UNIFORM</u> school. Uniforms are required Monday-Friday. Students are required to wear navy blue pants, shorts and skorts [must be fingertip length], or skirts, white polo shirts, and closed-toe shoes (tennis shoes preferred - no Crocs, sandals, etc.). Hoodies and sweaters are not to be worn around the waist. Jackets, sweaters, etc. may be worn in the classroom. If not, the clothing items must be hung up in the classroom.

Please note that there are times throughout the school year, where students will have uniform-free days. These days will be announced in advance by the teacher. School Hours and Student Arrival Time to School:

Please see the school hours and arrival time for students. Please adhere to the students' time of arrival for walkers/car riders. We are unable to receive, supervise, or monitor students who arrive at school prior to 8:55 a.m.

- School Hours: 9:15 a.m. 3:25 p.m.
- Student Arrival Time: 8:55 a.m.

Procedures for Morning Arrival of Students:

All doors will be marked, as well as, directional signs to guide parents and students to the correct area. Teachers will be posted outdoors to help parents, as needed. Teachers in the building will supervise students in the hallways.



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Arrival of Students by Bus and all Students in the Autism Program who are Car Riders: Front Lobby for Arrival

- All students who ride the bus will enter through the front lobby doors. Students will report directly to their class and will be supervised by staff.
- All students in the autism program will enter through the main lobby doors for arrival, whether a bus rider, walker, or car rider. The assigned staff member will receive their students in the front lobby to escort them to class.

Arrival of Students (Car Riders/Walkers): Cafeteria

Students who are walker/car riders and not in the autism program will enter through the side cafeteria doors:

- Grades PK-3 will enter through Door 2 and line up behind their grade-level for teachers to escort students to class.
- Grades 4 6 will enter through Door 1 and report directly to class. Staff will monitor students' movement, as they travel in the hallways to class.

*Procedure for Dismissal in the Afternoon:

Car Riders and Walkers

- Grades PK 6 will be dismissed (staggered), first, to report to the cafeteria and line up behind their teachers' names. Teachers will escort the students to the cafeteria. Teachers will ask for parent's/adult identification to verify the adult who is authorized to pick up the student.
- Parents and all persons who parents authorize to pick up their child, must show identification
 to verify with school records before the student is released. Parents are asked to please
 complete the electronic "Parent Consent to Authorize Student Pick-up at Dismissal for
 <u>Walkers/Car Riders</u>" to indicate who will be authorized to pick up their child at dismissal for
 walkers and car riders. Your child's teacher will forward this information to you when school
 opens.
- <u>Important</u>: Parents will report to the assigned door (PK-3 Door 2) (Gr. 4-6 Door 1) to pick-up their child (doors will be labeled). Parents will give the name of the student, sign the dismissal log, and present identification to the requesting teacher.
- *Please note that students who are in the autism program that are car riders for **dismissal only**, will report to the cafeteria, as well, with the appropriate SPED member who will supervise the student until received by the parent.

Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten Bus Riders: Safety Vests

Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten students will receive new safety vests to be worn to and from school each day. Parents, please ensure that you place the safety vest on your child in the morning to ride the bus. Students will receive their safety vest on the first day of school prior to the afternoon dismissal.
