WEDNESDAYS – continue to be asynchronous for all students. Follow teacher directions on how to be marked attended.

WHAT TO BRING TO SCHOOL

- Backpack. - Lockers WILL NOT be used.
- PGCPS issued Chromebook and charger.
 - Personal devices will not connect to the network. Please contact the school if your child does not have a county issued Chromebook.
- Headphones.
- Bottle of water.
- Lunch (Optional).
 - School lunch is free to all students and will be available to all students daily.
- Personal sized hand sanitizer. (optional – hand washing /sanitizing equipment is in all rooms and in the halls throughout the building.)
- Multiple clean face masks.
 - Face coverings are required to be worn unless eating –students should bring extra in the event that the one being worn is dirtied or torn. There will be disposable masks available to those who need one.

ARRIVAL

All students and visitors are subject to temperature checks upon entry to the building.

VISITORS

- All parents and visitors **MUST** call ahead to schedule an appointment before coming to the building. Only essential visits will be admitted. Most meetings will continue to be held virtually.

STUDENTS

- No student will enter the building prior to 9:15am (please dress accordingly).
 - Car riders should stay in their vehicles until 9:15am.
- All persons entering the building will enter through the main doors.
- Students exiting busses will be asked to stand on one of the marked 6ft distanced spots on the sidewalk under the canopy.
- Upon entry, students who wish to have a breakfast will take a grab-and-go breakfast from the table near the cafeteria doors and take it with them to eat in their classroom.
- Students will be directed to sanitize then line up in the locker area until their grade level is called to move to classrooms.

DEPARTURE

- Dismissal will begin at around 4:00pm.
- All students will exit the building through the center doors midway down the walkway under the canopy.
- Bus riders will be called 1 – 2 buses at a time to allow for safe movement out of the building.
 - Teachers and staff will be positioned throughout the building to ensure safe social distancing.
- Walkers and car riders will be dismissed at around 4:10pm and must promptly leave the school grounds.

EARLY DISMISSAL

- Notify the office the morning of the early dismissal.
- Upon arrival bring identification and come to the front door.
- The student will be released to you once pick-up authorization is confirmed.

TRANSPORTATION

The PGCPS Transportation department should have contacted families regarding bus transportation to inform of bus stop locations and pick-up/drop-off times.

If you have not already heard from Transportation, they can be reached at 301-952-6570 or search by your address on www.infofinder.com.

- Buses will begin arriving at school around 9:00am
- No cars will be allowed to enter the circle in front of the building to drop off students. Car riders should remain in their vehicles until 9:15am.
- All cars dropping off students should enter the parking lot and pull into a parking space.
- Students should walk across to the building using the crosswalk near the 'reserved' parking spaces.



PARENTS /STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

- Students should only attend in person if they are symptom free.
 - Parents should check temperatures at home and keep students at home when COVID symptoms are evidenced.
- Masks must be worn by students at all times except when eating breakfast or lunch.
- Students will follow an every 2 hour hand washing & hand sanitizing schedule established in class.
- Student will remain in their designated class unless traveling to lunch or creative arts.
 - ELA/Math/Sci./SS teachers will move to student locations
- If a student exhibits symptoms at school the parent will be called and the student must be picked up within an hour. Emergency contacts to pick-up should be up to date.
 - Parent/Guardian will follow up with a health care professional and advise the school nurse of student's ongoing health status.
- Parents should notify the principal/school nurse if the student has been exposed or diagnosed with COVID

IN THE CLASSROOM

- Desks will be identified with student names.
- Students will sit in the same desk each day they attend school.
- All desks are forward facing and spaced 6ft apart.
- All students will have a 'buddy' desk to store their belongings as lockers will not be used.
- Teachers will be positioned in such a way that they can monitor in class and at home students

HALLWAYS/RESTROOMS EXPECTATIONS

HALLWAYS

- Hallway signs directing students to practice social distancing and stay 6 ft apart are placed throughout the building
- Everyone must walk on the right side of the hallway



RESTROOMS

- No more than 3 students in restroom at a time
- Must remain 6ft apart
- Only one student per class at a time

MEALS

LUNCHES

- All lunches occur during 3rd mod. (See the schedule on slide 5.)
- Students will move to the cafeteria for lunch at the scheduled time each day.
- Students will sit in an assigned lunch seat each day.
- Students will sit on the side of the lunch table facing the front of the cafeteria.
- Lunch is free to all students for the remainder of the school year.
- A hot lunch will be served each day.
- **Lunch is a set menu, there are no options available.**

NOTE: No food should be ordered or brought for delivery to students.

All such orders will be sent back with the person delivering it.

BREAKFAST

- Breakfast will be offered to all students at no cost. Students can pick up a bag on the way in to school.

SUPPER

- On the way out at dismissal, students can pick up a bag for their supper meal at home.
