Benchmark Testing November 9th - 11th - During the year, students will be taking benchmark assessments for specific classes. The first of these benchmarks are administered at the beginning of November and they assess the demonstration of learning for students for first quarter. Students are encouraged to do their best on these assessments as teachers use the results to plan and adjust for instruction. Students in all grades will take the Math and Reading benchmarks and 8th grade students will

additionally take benchmark assessments in Science and Social Studies as part of their cumulative demonstration of a well-rounded curriculum for middle school.


